➤ *GPA language for website and handbook:*

BSN: 3.0 GPA minimum **highly** recommended.

ABSN/ELMS: 3.0 GPA minimum **highly** recommended for last 60 semester or 90 quarter units. 3.0 science GPA minimum **highly** recommended (science prerequisites only)

➤ *TEAS Language for website and handbook:*

All applicants for admission are required to take the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS). TEAS scores will be compared to national benchmark standards.

Page 99 Graduate Progression and Graduation
Continued Enrollment (replaces 3rd paragraph)

Graduate students in the Master of Occupational Therapy, Master Physician Assistant, and Master of Science in Nursing programs must achieve satisfactory academic performance, including: a minimum grade of "C" in all required courses; a grade of "S" on all clinical experiences; and a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (MOT/MPA) and 3.0 (MSN). Graduate students in the Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) program must achieve a minimum grade of "C-" (70%) on all courses in the first semester of the program and a minimum grade of "C" (73%) in all courses or "S" in all clinical experiences in subsequent semesters. Students in the DPT program must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.5.
